Schedule "A"

4 - Statement of the purpose of the corporation

The purpose of the corporation is to:

- 1. Advance the charitable mission of Vincentians, in serving the needs of people experiencing poverty, with a focus on those within the Greater Toronto Area.
- 2. Co-operate with other groups and Vincentian organisations to further any work of charity in Canada that serves to address those in need.
- 3. Provide a stable living environment for the disadvantaged by establishing and operating:
 - (a) emergency shelters, supportive and transitional housing;
 - (b) residential housing for people of low income; and
 - (c) camps for children of low income families.
- 4. Provide basic supplies for the imprisoned and their families within Ontario.

Schedule "B"

8 - Additional provisions, if any

- (a) The corporation is to be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other accretions to the Corporation shall be used in furtherance of its purposes.
- (b) Directors shall serve without remuneration, and no director shall directly or indirectly receive any profit from his or her position as such, provided that a director may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred in performing his or her services.
